"I've dreamt of holding up an Olympic medal ever since I can remember. When we were kids, watching the Games, Dad said 'someone has to be the best, so why can't it be you?' That really fuelled me and it wasn't long before I hit my first jump," Beau-James Wells said.

With the lead up to the Olympic Winter Games now well and truly in full swing, Wells says the last few months have been dedicated to ensuring he's totally prepared to fulfil his aspirations, using his setback as a new motivation.

"Being told you can't do what you love for a whole year, to me that's heartbreaking. But you can turn that pain into a new hunger and now I'm coming back stronger."
